Ramagundam Floating Solar PV Project is India's largest Floating Solar Plant commissioned by NTPC. Now the total commercial operation of Floating Solar Capacity in Southern Region has reached 217 MW. Prior to this, NTPC declared Commercial operation of 92 MW Floating Solar at **Kayamkulam (Kerala)** and **25 MW Floating Solar at Simhadri (Andhra Pradesh)**.

14. Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao on Tuesday showered sops — ranging from free education till class 12 to aiding preparation for competitive exams — on students belonging to backward classes, scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and minorities. The CM directed officials to upgrade existing government residential schools (gurukulams) of BCs, SCs, STs and minorities for the introduction of Intermediate courses from the current academic year (2022-23). Besides, 15 women's residential degree colleges are to be set up this academic year, and 17 more institutes from the next academic year, to cover all 33 district.

12. Women to make up 20% of Naval Agniveer force. New Delhi: The Indian Navy intends to recruit women for 20 per cent vacancies in the first batch of the Agniveers.

The women sailors recruited under new four-year term Agnipath scheme will be sent to different parts and branches of the Navy. In the current financial year, the Indian Navy will be hiring 3,000 sailors, including both men and women, under the Agnipath scheme.

The Indian Navy had started the online registration process on July 1.

ACB raids various locations of Karnataka Congress MLA Zameer Ahmed Khan Bengaluru: The Anti-Corruption Bureau in Karnataka on Tuesday raided five locations of Congress MLA B Z Zameer Ahmed Khan following a report of the Enforcement Directorate. According to ACB officials, the raids were carried out at his residence near

the Cantonment Railway station, a flat in Silver Oak Apartment, a guest house at Sadashivanagar, G K Associates office at Banashankari and National Travels office in Kalasipalya in the city.

"The ACB teams are verifying the documents and the investigation is on," the ACB official said.

Ketanji Brown Jackson sworn in, becomes 1st black woman on US supreme court. **The United States** made history as **Ketanji Brown Jackson** was sworn in as the **first Black woman** to serve on the **Supreme Court**. The 51-year-old's appointment by Democratic President Joe Biden means white men are not in the majority on the nation's highest court for the first time in 233 years. Four of the justices on the nine-member court are now women, making it the most diverse bench in history — although they all attended the elite law schools of Harvard or Yale.

Judge in SC Bench Critical of Nupur Sharma Speaks Against Personal Attacks on Social Media. 'In India, which cannot be defined as a completely mature or defined democracy, social media is employed frequently to politicise purely legal and constitutional issues,' Justice Pardiwala said. New Delhi: Justice J.B. Pardiwala, one of the judges in the Supreme Court bench which had been critical of Bharatiya Janata Party leader Nupur Sharma's anti-Islam comments, has said that personal attacks on judges makes them consider what the media thinks more than what the law thinks. The judge also called for the regulation of social media to this end.

NDTV has reported that the judge, speaking at a public event on Sunday, July 3, said that "personal attacks on judges for their judgments lead to a dangerous scenario."

LiveLaw has reported that the occasion was the Second Justice HR Khanna Memorial National Symposium, hosted by Dr. Ram Manohar Lohiya National Law University and National Law University, Odisha, with the CAN Foundation.

A bench of the Supreme Court on July 1 had come down heavily on Sharma for her remarks on national television against Prophet Mohammed, observing that it was made either for cheap publicity, political agenda or some nefarious activities. “The way she has ignited emotions across the country. This lady is single-handedly responsible for what is happening in the country. We saw the debate on how she was incited. But the way she said all this and later says she was a lawyer, it is shameful. She should apologise to the whole country,” Justice Surya Kant said.
